Grace and Peace Beloved of God,

conference ministers, staff, clergy, and lay leaders from the current four conferences (North, South, Central, and West) diligently have been in discernment. Please keep in your prayers the people across the state who have volunteered to lead us through this consideration.

May we remember that God has called us apart from the world, ambassadors of Christ, and makes an appeal through us to be reconciled to God (2 Corinthians 5). May our prayers, commitment to sharing the Gospel, and compassion for people cause those who are lost, fearful, angry, and vengeful to turn back to God, humble ourselves, and stop our ways of disobedience. For God has faithfully declared to hear our repentance, forgive our sins, and heal our land (2 Chronicles 7:14-20). Be encouraged and love your neighbor regardless of their beliefs. May we all be used as loving vessels of peace, grace, and mercy.
